

TRACK EXPANSION REPORT

On Track

Hard to believe, here we are nearing the end of another KLS public run season.

The track has been in great shape all year, due primarily to the hard work of those members who dedicate their time and effort to maintaining the track.

There's still much to do, as more of the old aluminum rail shows signs of severe wear and aging and needs to be replaced. We have a good supply of steel rail on hand now, so there's plenty of opportunity for anyone who wants to come out and support the railroad.

Our next big work day, to continue the mainline expansion project, is set for Saturday, September 7th, unless the weather turns particularly onerous.

We'll get started at 0900, working north of the Middle Loop, adding track between the diamond crossing and the north-east corner of the North Loop.



By the time you are reading this all the South Loop track will be laid, and although it will probably still need trimming to be perfectly smooth we can run work trains on it to get to the work area. We'll use the gravel spreader to lay the sub-ballast, and we'll have the big green gondola for putting rock along the sides of the track.

Plan for a big day of hard work playing in the dirt. It should be lots of fun.

AUGUST YARD & BUILDINGS WORK REPORT Full Steam Ahead!

This past month we have been building track and building framing for the metal storage building.

Thanks to all the members who donate their valuable time and efforts working on the KLS Railroad.

Here is a sampling of the work we completed in August.

- Installed 160 feet of new track on the South Loop Big Curve.
 Big job! Thanks Dan Simmons, Bill Hartung, Steve Tinner,
 Greg Slobodzian, Bill Dumbaugh.
- Procured 8 replacement locks as backups for lock failures and wear.
- Installed 80 feet of new track on the South Loop. (Steve Tinner, Bill Dumbaugh)
- Framing in progress on the Yard Compound 22x24 Metal Building. (Tom Huffman).

Upcoming Plans:

- Continue to replace aluminum frogs with steel frogs as they become available.
- Construct the Maintenance/Storage Building in the KLS Yard Compound.
- Install new locking table support hinges on the four depot tables.
- Refurbish picnic table near the loading area.
- Raise the grade on the track section near the Wye on the west side.
- Build new track.

This year's event will be the evening of October 26th between 5pm and 9pm.


As most of you know, the Ghost Train is Kitsap Foster Care Association's biggest fundraiser of the year. The money raised from the Ghost Train will

fund all the KFCA's activities for the entire year such as Mariner's tickets, holiday gifts, backpacks full of school supplies and monthly dinner support group meetings among other things.



Our regular run day on October 26th will start at 10am and end at 1pm. This will allow

the train crews some time to eat, check equipment and relax before the



Association members time to decorate the depot, get the line fencing setup and allow their vignettes to get setup and in position.

There will be a mandatory briefing for all KLS Ghost Train personnel at 4pm, the run will commence at 5 pm with plans to end at 9 pm.

WHAT WE NEED:

- 1. Locomotives pulling 2 passenger cars each. KLS will supply the cars.
- 2. Engineers and Conductors.
- 3. People to staff the depot and man the entry/exit gates, depot entry switch, and to help load and unload passengers.
- 4. Crash Crew personnel so we can respond in case of a derailment or other problem out on the line.

Ticket sales will be fixed at 1,600 riders for the four hour run. The pace will be intense and we'll need lots of help. I would like to have key positions assigned so we can be better prepared.

This is a super fun event. Not only is it our only night run of the year, it's a great opportunity for KLS to help the Kitsap Foster Care Association. Please, come on out and help.


