Steve Tinner Since joining KLS in July 2017

Steve Tinner has been in integral part of building and maintenance efforts at the track. Of the approximately 2,000 linear feet of track panels that has been installed, Steve has been responsible for building around ninety percent of it. Some of the other projects he has been involved with include:

- French drain instal along the concrete unloading pad preventing water buildup.
- Layed over 1,500 feet of track in the new South loop.
- Trimming and gravel work on the new South loop track.
- Building the new metal storage building in the yard compound.
- Install of a water hydrant in the yard compound.
- Built forms for a new concrete BBQ area.
- Installed a personnel door in the new metal building.
- Wooden picnic table refurbishment.

Steve has made himself a very valuable member of the KLS work groups. Whenever work is going on at KLS Steve is always involved and ready to go.

This past year of 2019 was a great one for the KLS track, for it's overall condition and for the growth of the mainline as the new extension project neared completion. I attribute that directly to the hard work of many of you who have volunlivesteamers.org teered your time and effort during the year.

We had several great 'all hands' track laying days in which roughly 2000 feet of the extension was completed. As I write this we have about 500 feet to go and the first phase of the extension will be ready for use. Of course there'll be the usual trimming required before the 2020 public season begins...

Mother Nature always applies her usual

tricks to the track during the Winter.

Additionally, the efforts of so many KLS members who came to the park during the

week to address the worn out rail issues have really paid off. The track was more stable and required less mid-season trimming due to the new steel rail replacing the old aluminum pieces.

There'll be ample opportunities to continue that work, along with completing the new extension, as we get close to the April 11th opening day.

I want to give a great big thanks to all of you who have put in the time at the park working on the track. It's your railroad and you are the direct recipients of the progress that has been made.

Finally, this is my last report as the track committee chairman. My term as a KLS director is ending and I'll be handing this job over to my successor. I wish him well and encourage everyone to stay energized and excited about supporting the daily operations and the long term projects that make KLS tick. I'll still be around and will do my part to support KLS activities, including working on the

# Full Steam Ahead!

Our KLS week day yard and track crews managed to find plenty to do during December.

Winter work days are: January 25th, February 8th, and 22nd and March 14th. The fun starts at 9am!

### Here is a sampling of the work we completed in December:

- Replaced 2 worn aluminum frogs with new steel frogs
- New metal building passed final county inspection and Fire Marshall Occupancy Inspection
- Cleaned and disinfected bathroom walls and fixtures (Jim Sigman)
- Procured and painted boards for weather damaged yard picnic table (Jim Sigman)

- Rehabbed picnic table near the Rail Wheel Bench (Steve Tinner, Garrett Zimmerman)
- Installed a ceiling fan with light kit in the Thomson Building to help with more even distribution of the output from the heater
- Insulation installed in the New Metal Bldg (Boulton Insulation)
- Replaced 2 burned out CFL's in the Thomson storage room with high performance LED lights. All CFL's will most likely be changed as they show signs of wearing out.
- Numbered the roll up doors on the new metal building

## **Upcoming Plans:**

- Continue to replace aluminum frogs with steel frogs as they become available
- Install new locking table support hinges on depot tables
- Raise the grade on the track section near the Wye on the west side
- Build new track

## **Important notes:**

- 1. The heaters in the buildings now have a thermostat control, so it is very important to check that the electrical breakers to the heaters are switched "off" when you lock up to leave even if you don't hear the heater running. This will ensure the heaters are actually off keeping our electrical bill from skyrocketing.
- 2. Don't forget to sign in every time you visit the track and be safe.
- 3. Please, return borrowed tools to where you got them from. We are still missing some tools. If you find them, please return them.
- 4. Lower the hydraulic lift completely, turn off the power and lock the switch after use.
