The County Park was closed due to the corona virus pandemic on March 26, 2020 and we have accomplished not a darn thing since then. Hopefully we can get back in and get to work soon. Here is what I was able to accomplish in April.

We did completed a couple of things in April:

- Performed security checks on the KLS site at least once a week.
- Manufacturing some new and improved kick switch catch parts to be installed after the park reopens.

Upcoming plans as the situation allows:

- Continue to replace aluminum frogs with steel frogs as they become available.
- Coat the new building floor with epoxy paint.
- Raise the grade on the track section near the Wye on the west side and at the dip on the east side of the north loop.
- Continue working on new track.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE

1.

Some of our members bring in Borax powder to use as hand cleaner. Please note that powdered Borax has been found to be a respiratory and digestive irritant by the FDA. It has been banned for use in the European Union and Canada

I will make sure that we have plenty of safe and effective non Borax hand cleaners available at the track for our members to use. It is okay for individual members to bring Borax powder in for personal use, but please take it with you when you leave..

Don't forget to sign in each time you visit the track.

Return borrowed tools to where you got them from. Some are missing. If found, return them.

4.

Lower the hydraulic lift completely, turn off the power and lock the switch after use.

Planting Will Continue!

When things open up we'll continue replanting the forest with native plants. There is much work left to do removing big patches of invasive species such as ivy, holly, spurge laurel, thistles and shiny geranium.

Planting workdays — same as track workdays.

Conductor and Engineer Training

KLS Engineer and Conductor training was scheduled to be held on March 28th, but unfortunately South Kitsap Park has been shut down due to the Corona virus outbreak and we will not be able to meet. Training will be held at some point in the future, I am just not sure when. Watch for future emails and Facebook announcements for more news.

Prospective Conductors and Engineers are asked to go ahead and fill out the Conductor and/or Engineer Qualification Exams as applicable and bring their COMPLETED exams with them to the training. Also bring a copy of the Conductor and/or Engineer Operating Exams but do not fill these out as they will be completed during the "hands on" part of the training.

The Conductor/Engineer Qualification exams are found in the KLS Conduct of Operations (CofO), on pages 41 and 47 respectively and should be completed "open book" at home. The Conduct of Operations document may be downloaded from the KLS website:

- Log on to the KLS website, then click on the "Members Only" tab, then select "Be a Conductor/Engineer,
- 2. Then, click the KLS Conduct of Operations 2-6-17 highlighted area and view and/or download the document. All the answers to the exam questions can be found in the CofO.

This is an OPEN BOOK exam! The purpose of completing the qualification exam before hand is to get our prospective Engineers and Conductors familiar with the KLS CofO, which is the primary guideline under which KLS operates the trains and equipment. Persons who have tried to complete the training in the past without first becoming familiar with the CofO have been unsuccessful.

Training session will be for both new members and also those wishing to refresh their knowledge.
